

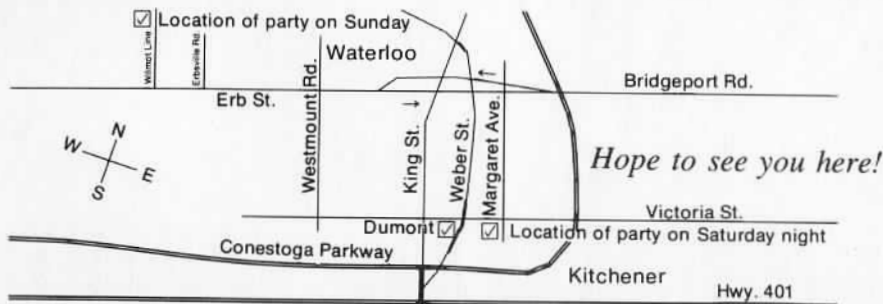
# TEN YEARS OF THIS?

Erb St. in Waterloo can be reached indirectly from either King St. or the Conestoga Parkway. In either case you must get onto Bridgeport Rd. heading west. From the Conestoga Parkway, exit onto Bridgeport Rd. and proceed towards downtown. After crossing King St., Bridgeport Rd. curves to the left and meets Erb St. Turn right onto Erb St., heading west away from downtown. Cross Westmount Rd. and continue along past the urban sprawl. By the Erbsville Rd. (at the flashing light) you will be high up between farmers' fields, probably unprepared for the sight of the garbage dump on the left further along the road. The first road on the right after the dump is the Wilmot Line. There is a large sign at this intersection reading: "To Valpine Park". Turn right (north) along this road. You will see signs marking the location of the party.
