6)We want talked about and hope to reconstitute specialized groupings around camera and keyboarding esp. and maybe pasteup. These groups would put together handbooks based on discussions of technique, was work habits etc. At certain points (after significant enlightenment has been attained) the groups will make presentations to all Dumoniters in general meetings. camera: Steve, Gary, Linda; Keyboarding: Janex, Mike C; paste-up: Mike C,

- 7) Mike C suggests that for most common work (chevron etc.) that proofing be done once with one person. Paragraphs, names and numbers should be checked against original copy. This will apply immediately except, of course, for "important" work like books.
 - 8) Black Rose has a book for us to typeset. They have been quoted our regular book rates. Steve will draw up an agreement involving typesetting scedule and payment, and will co-ordinate the production. The book will be in sometime around the first week of June and we will kx have about eight weeks to typeset it. Payment will be approx. half the amount at time of submission, one-sixth at end of each 30 day period following completion so that total payment ix will be received by us within 90 days of completion.
 - 9) Ontarion: have asked us for a w quote. Jane g figures it will be about 16 pages weekly in the summer, and up to 32 pages weekly during the other two terms. Gary and Jane will talk to them about details; we will give them chevron prices probably.
 - 10) Publishing: various details of gov't monies and grants need to be collected; agreements worked out with OPIRG and Federation of Students. Steve will hvae one shift per week to do this. Distribution will be covered outside of this shift. Therefore one shift for distribution and one shift for bureaucratic stuff will be considered as equity invested in DPG by Dumont.
